Notes

1. This chapter deals with "Action With Respect to Threats to the Peace, Breaches of the Peace, and Acts of Aggression". It empowers the Security Council to decide on measures to be taken to restore peace (implicitly, once a dispute has degenerated into armed conflict and has been identified by the Security Council as a threat to the peace, breach of the peace, or act of aggression). Chapter VII is essentially coercive. Through Chapter VII, the UN Security Council is empowered to investigate alleged violations and then determine measures to be taken against the states concerned. These measures can include political and economic pressure as well as the use of force (Article 42).
